Streaker Report

Hornsea Opens always seems to have an abundance of sunshine and a good force 3, and this year was no exception. Twenty-six boats lined-up to start the first race, which got away cleanly at the bell. Local sailor Dave Metcalfe won the start, but at the wrong end of the line, which allowed tardier starters at the right end of the line to cross in front on port tack. Alan Gillard, 1691 from Sheffield Vikings, was first to the windward mark, followed by Dave Smith, 1670, from Welton. Several boats, including the leaders, decided to head off for the wrong mark, but corrected in time when they noticed local sailor Jeremy Wood sailing a different course. Alan Gillard stretched his lead and held it to the finish, with Nick Lovell, 1541, Ouse Amateur, coming through to take second, with Smith third. Matt Whitfield, 1446, Tamworth SC, seventh at the first windward mark, showed good speed to climb up to third, only to have gear failure and drop back to eleventh.

In Race 2, Metcalfe, using his local knowledge, arrived at the windward mark alongside Gillard. For a lap the two of them pulled out a small lead, but were gradually caught by Smith and Whitfield. Smith took the lead for lap 3, but was passed by Gillard on the final lap. Whitfield took third, Metcalfe fourth and Ian Bradley, 1619, Ouse Amateur SC, fifth.

With the meeting already won Alan Gillard still came out to sail the final race. OOD Stephen Sharp set another different course, which made everybody think yet again. This time Gillard led from start to finish, with the minor placings behind changing considerably throughout the race. Jeremy Wood was the surprise package this time; fifth round the windward mark, he had moved up to second by lap three, but was caught by Dave Smith just before the finish. Matt Whitfield again showed tremendous form to finish fourth.

Final placings were Alan Gillard first, Dave Smith second, Matt Whitfield third, Nick Lovell fourth, Jeremy Wood fifth.
